ÖKOLOG - Ecologisation of schools - Education for sustainability strives...

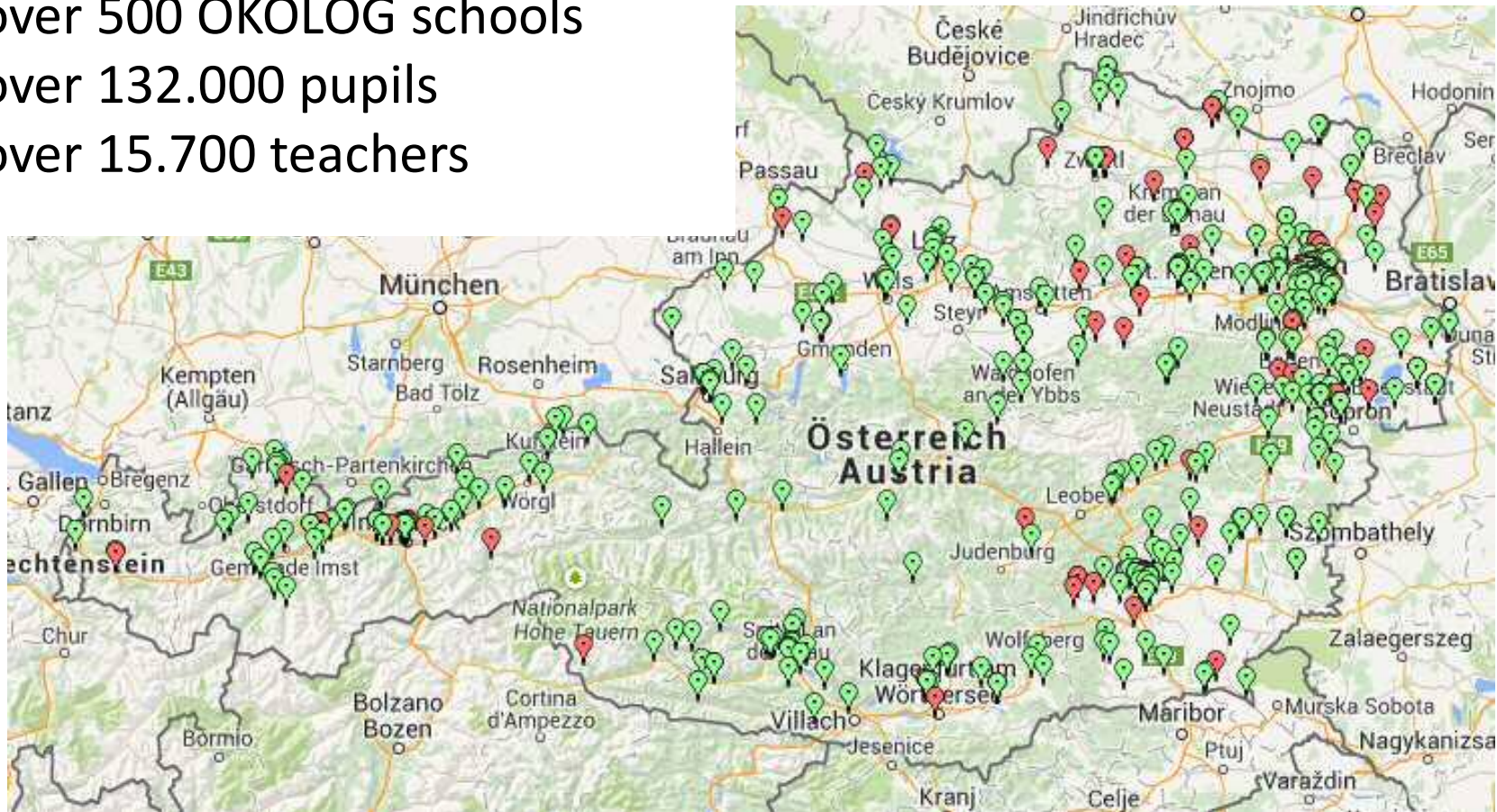
- towards lasting, sustainable quality of life

ÖKOLOG and ESD

- ÖKOLOG is a programme for environmental education and school development at Austrian schools
- makes a contribution to the Global Goals for Sustainable Development (SDGs)
- Was initiated and is supported by the Ministry of Education

- over 132.000 pupils
- over 15.700 teachers

ÖKOLOGisation

Schools that strive towards ecologisation

- save resources, reduce pollution, design rooms and grounds that are ecologically and ethically acceptable and promote health
- promote ecologically exemplary attitudes, ways of thinking and actions within schools, families and communities

ÖKOLOGisation

Schools that strive towards ecologisation:

- build a social climate that is characterised by a respectful interaction with each other
- build structures in which participation and participative decision-making are possible
- work together with the social environment of their school
